## ***BPS Psychology of Women & Equalities Section*** **Student Awards**

*Submissions can include research from all areas of Psychology, and the Social Sciences. The article must be clearly related to the research carried out as part of an undergraduate degree. Individual entries and group submissions are both welcomed but must not have been published previously. Articles must make an original contribution.*

**POWES Spotlight on Inequalities Undergraduate (UG) Award** For this year – ‘race’ inequalities (e.g., asylum seekers’ healthcare experiences) – or ‘race’ AND other intersecting inequalities (e.g., the representation of Muslim South Asian women on Instagram).

**POWES Undergraduate Gender Inequalities (UG) Award** Gender inequalities (e.g., the sexism of neuroscience) OR gender AND other intersecting inequalities (e.g., Black women’s perinatal experiences, queer women's coming out stories).

Word count for the submission is 3000 words (does not include Abstract, Title, References, data extracts or tables). Abstracts can be a maximum of 200 words

**This award includes prizes of:**

- A funded place at the POWES 2020 Conference (8-10<sup>th</sup> July 2020)
- The opportunity to present your paper at the Conference
- A subscription to **POWER** for one year
- Assisted publication of your submission in **POWER** subject to standard peer-review process
- Award certificate

**POWES will reimburse your full conference fee (including registration, meals and shared accommodation) and travel to the conference up to the maximum amount of £150.**

**Commendations:** Please note as feminist scholars, we are wary of the competitive nature of research and therefore all entrants to the prizes that have substantial merit will receive commendations including a certificate of recognition.
